# Subject: THUNDERSTORM-RAIN AND FLOOD WARNING FOR KALPANI NULLAH, MARDAN

### Dear Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD), Regional Met Office, Peshawar, informed that heavy to very heavy rains from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2025 predicted in District Mardan during the current monsoon and westerly low-pressure system.

### Under the influence of these meteorological conditions:

• Rain – wind/ thundershower with scattered heavy falls (sometimes very heavy) accompanied by lightning and gusty winds may generate flash floods in local nullahs/ streams, especially in Kalpani Nullah District, Mardan, from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> July.

Possible Impacts:

- Heavy to very heavy rains may generate flash floods in local nullah/streams and Kalpani river of Mardan
- Heavy falls/windstorms and lightning may damage weak structures like the roof/wall of Kacha houses, electric poles, billboards, vehicles, and solar panels, etc., during the forecast period.

It is therefore requested to kindly take all precautionary measures in order to avoid/ minimize human losses and/or any damages to infrastructure and livestock. Furthermore, all concerned authorities are requested to take the following safety measures:

- a) Local administrations to assess and plan deployment of additional resources and exercise Advice concerned with keeping monitoring on Streams, Local/ Barsati Nullahs, especially Kalpani Nullah.
- b) Ensure that drainage systems are clear of debris and obstacles to facilitate the efficient flow of water and minimize the risk of urban flooding.
- c) Coordinates with relevant municipal administrations to ensure mitigation & preparedness measures for urban flooding and to secure or remove billboards/ hoardings because of wind-dust/ thunderstorm.
- d) Farmers to be advised to take all necessary mitigative and precautionary measures to safeguard their crops, i.e., timely harvesting, safe storage, or any other precaution from adverse effects of wind-dust/ thunderstorm & flash floods.
- e) Cattle/ sheep herders to be advised to undertake necessary mitigative and precautionary measures to protect their livestock, i.e., safe sheltering or any other precaution from adverse effects of wind-dust/ thunderstorm & flash floods.
- f) The general public is advised to seek shelter in safe areas such as sturdy buildings or underground structures during wind-dust/ thunderstorm, hailstorm, and avoid objects that pose a risk of failing or being struck by lightning.
- g) Ensure availability of emergency services personnel and equipment in areas at high risk of urban flooding and flash flooding.
- h) Ensure immediate stocking of basic commodities, including paramedics & medicine.
- i) Ensure widespread circulation of alerts and advisories, especially in local languages, to raise awareness and sensitize local communities in at-risk/ vulnerable areas.
- j) Ensure round-the-clock monitoring of the situation through Emergency Operations Centers (EOCs).
